The Mustard Seed Foundation is a Christian family foundation established in 1983 under the leadership of Dennis W. Bakke and Eileen Harvey Bakke. The Foundation was created as an expression of their desire to be faithful stewards of the financial resources entrusted to them, to bring together the members of their extended families into common ministry, and to advance the Kingdom of God. The Foundation provides grants to churches and Christian organizations worldwide that are undertaking new ministry projects including outreach, discipleship, and economic empowerment. The Foundation also awards scholarships to Christians pursuing advanced educational degrees in preparation for leadership roles in both the Church and society. The Foundation affirms the Lausanne Covenant as its missional commitment to the world. All directors and staff of the Mustard Seed Foundation are committed followers of Jesus Christ.

Dear Friends

of the Mustard Seed Foundation,

The 27th year of the Mustard Seed Foundation was characterized by continued recovery and consolidation following the 2008 global economic recession. Our total giving for 2010 was \$4.7 million, a reduction of \$300,000 from giving in 2009. The Foundation awarded 508 grants, nearly 100% of which went to local churches in 76 countries. It is not easy work discovering and funding worthwhile projects from local churches that are seeking to love their neighbors and to share the good news of the Christian faith. We are grateful for the team of eleven Mustard Seed staff members, six of whom live and work outside the United States.

Our average grant size was a little more than \$5,000. This grant size has remained fairly constant through the Foundation's history and has characterized our work to fund grassroots, indigenous ministries. These grants, which are small by U.S. and European standards, are intentionally sized to be appropriate matches for church projects. We believe the grants have significant impact as these "mustard seeds" grow and multiply the work of local church congregations.

In addition to our church-based granting program, Mustard Seed sponsors several scholarship programs. Our Theological Education Scholarship Program partners with international seminaries to fund deserving graduate students who will become pastors and ministers. In 2010, 193 students from 31 seminaries and theological schools received \$300,000 in scholarships. In addition, Mustard Seed partnered with Bakke Graduate University (BGU) to provide nearly \$300,000 in financial assistance to 147 international graduate students.

The Foundation awarded \$894,000 to 81 students through the Harvey Fellows Program, which seeks to identify and support top graduate students who desire to serve Christ in arenas where Christians are often underrepresented, such as academia, the arts, international policy, the sciences, and media.

One of the fastest growing programs of Mustard Seed is our granting to a number of seminaries and universities worldwide that are teaching courses in the "Theology of Work." In 2010 the Foundation awarded 29 grants totaling nearly \$300,000 to teach "theology of work" courses to nearly 7,000 students in both formal and informal courses, both in the U.S. and abroad.

The year was marked by the death of Savina Tong, a beloved MSF staff member, after a valiant struggle against cancer. Savina was an extraordinarily gifted, energetic and courageous woman. For eight years Savina worked tirelessly and creatively to enable MSF to provide grants to Chinese official and house churches. We miss her both as a friend and for the extraordinary work she did to further Christ's Kingdom through the Foundation.

Mustard Seed is a family foundation, whose board members are chosen from the extended Bakke and Harvey families. This year, Whit Harvey and Norris Laffitte chaired the Junior Board, comprised of family members ages 13 – 18 years old. Helen Laffitte, who has served several terms on the Senior Board, rotated off the Board. Cathy Harvey joined the Board for the first time, serving a 5-year term. In 2010 we were also pleased to welcome new staff member Amy Chan from Hong Kong to help continue the Mustard Seed Foundation's work in China and neighboring countries.

Each year as we reflect on our efforts to minister in Christ's name through stewarding the funds He has provided, we are humbled by our mistakes and overjoyed by the opportunity given us to fund mission work worldwide. We ask our Lord to strengthen our desire to serve Him in this important ministry. We pray for the believers and churches throughout the world with whom we have the privilege of partnering in ministry.

Guiding Principles

Christ and His Kingdom

The gospel of Jesus Christ and the advancement of his Kingdom are central to all that we are and all that we do. It is our joy to worship and serve him and to submit ourselves to the authority of the Bible. We seek to be Christ's servants and ambassadors and to encourage as many as will come to follow Christ. We seek to encourage the formation of disciples from every "unreached" community, city, and culture. We desire to see the whole Church bring the whole gospel to the whole world. Therefore, we award grants and scholarships to churches and individuals representing the spectrum of biblical Christianity, including Orthodox, Catholic, Protestant, and Evangelical traditions. We affirm God's redeeming and restorative grace and power as sufficient to bring blessing to all structures, institutions, and societies. All grant and scholarship recipients of the Mustard Seed Foundation must proclaim a personal faith in Christ, affirm the basic tenets of orthodox Christianity, and desire to serve and witness in Christ's name.

Global

The Mustard Seed Foundation recognizes the global nature of the Body of Christ. Therefore, we desire to participate in God's work to encourage churches and individuals through grants and scholarships around the world. Our goal is to give the majority of our funding to churches and individuals worldwide, while intentionally limiting our investment in the United States. Since the Foundation's inception in 1983, we have awarded grants and scholarships in nearly 150 countries.

Local Church

We recognize the Church as God's primary representative in the world. Therefore, we try to maximize the role and responsibility of local congregations in the initiatives we support. We seek to partner with and empower local congregations to identify, equip, and support their members


who are called to specific areas of ministry in the Church, marketplace, and the world. We also consider local church support and accountability as primary indicators of the priority, integrity, and sustainability of any potential grant or scholarship initiative.


Individuals In Community

We believe that God endows individuals with the passions and gifts needed to further the work of his Kingdom. We believe that God desires those whom he calls and equips to be both nurtured by and held accountable to the local body of Christ. It is our belief that individuals are strongest and most able to fulfill their callings when they are integral members of a local church. Thus, in all our giving we seek to support individuals who are active members of a church community. The power of individuals to be agents of grace and change in community is exemplified in history. We therefore seek opportunities to empower individuals who are clearly affirmed and supported by their local church to use their unique gifts to fulfill their callings.

Small Beginnings

The biblical parable of the mustard seed reminds us that great things often have small beginnings. Through abiding in Christ and following him our seemingly small efforts possess power beyond imagination. This parable exhorts us to respond faithfully to God's calling but to trust outcomes to him. In our giving we seek to trust individuals and churches as they listen to God by taking small steps toward their visions. Therefore, our grants are available to churches, including those that may be poor, powerless, or unproven. We recognize that results cannot be guaranteed and that big results often have risky beginnings. We choose to specialize in small, start-up initiatives, trusting that what is sown in faith will return abundantly.





2010

Overview

The Foundation's expenditures totaled \$5.5 million in 2010. Over 80 percent of these funds were given through 537 grants to churches and Christian organizations, and over 420 scholarships to individuals. The remaining 16.7 percent, or \$928,897, was used to administer this work through an international team of 11 staff located in seven countries around the globe.

Providing seed funding for small startup projects of churches and Christian organizations around the world remains the primary giving area of the Foundation. Over 47 percent, or \$2,627,620, of total operating expenditures was given through grants primarily to local churches in major urban centers worldwide. Our average grant award held steady to our historical average of around \$5,000.

The remainder of the Foundation's giving was channeled through a variety of other giving programs. The Harvey Fellows Program decreased slightly in 2010 over 2009, but we selected 23 new fellows and hosted a Summer Institute. Our Theological Education scholarships remained at a consistent level of funding but the program was restructured to only give scholarships to unique theological students from around the world. Our funding of scholarships to graduate students at Bakke Graduate University also remained constant, although we supported a larger number of students than in 2009. Our Theology of Work grant program increased over 2009 to continue to teach this theology at international teaching institutions. We also resumed matching gifts of our board and staff members to Christian organizations in 2010. Together these initiatives represent 36 percent, or \$1,999,153, of our 2010 expenditures.

Grants

Awarded in 2010

As our name implies, the *Mustard Seed Foundation* provides seed funding for small startup projects of churches and Christian organizations around the world. We seek to partner with local congregations that identify, equip, and support their members who are called to specific areas of ministry in the Church and society. We look for initiatives that offer innovative approaches to church-based ministries.

Mustard Seed seeks to help launch projects through its grants as a minority partner, providing funds over a limited time period, and in a way that encourages self-sufficiency and reliance on indigenous church support. We consider local church accountability and financial support primary indicators of the priority and integrity of particular project and key to its long-term sustainability. All of the funds given as grants are matched by funds from local churches connected to the projects.

The Foundation recognizes the unique challenges and opportunities faced by urban churches. As the world rapidly urbanizes, we believe that investing in churches located in large cities to be particularly strategic. Therefore, the Foundation awards most grants in the largest urban centers of the world.

Mustard Seed awards grants to a wide variety of projects. We typically fund initiatives that share the gospel with non-Christians (outreach), generate income and economic decision-making opportunities to poorer Christians (empowerment), or equip Christians to better proclaim and demonstrate the gospel (discipleship).

In 2010 we were pleased to award \$2,627,620 matched by local churches to help establish 508 new innovative ministries in the largest urban centers of the world.





T.A. Bakke Award

Each year the Mustard Seed Foundation designates one grant award as a special tribute to the life of one of our founding board members. Tollef A. Bakke was a second generation Norwegian immigrant who lived and worked in the Pacific Northwest and Colorado. He also participated in a trip to the Holy Land that profoundly influenced his faith.

We recognize the grant award to Maadi Evangelical Church in Cairo, Egypt as our 2010 Tollef A. Bakke Award. This award was a \$5,000 grant matching church support at a 1:2 ratio to minister to families with disabled children.



Savina Tong Award

This year the Foundation has selected a grant award in honor of one of our staff members who passed away in 2010. Savina Tong represented the Foundation for eight years to encourage the work of local churches in East Asia. Savina helped the Foundation to connect with the fast-growing church in mainland China and support initiatives to plant churches in major urban centers, train local church-based ministers, and launch social outreach ministries. She also facilitated the Foundation's granting in more open locations such as Hong Kong and Taiwan. Savina went to be with the Lord on May 4, 2010 after a courageous yearlong battle with cancer. We established the Savina Tong Award as a tribute to her life and ministry among us.

We recognize the grant award to Christian Mission Center of Grace in Hong Kong, China as our 2010 Savina Tong Award. This award was a \$10,000 grant matching church support to establish a Chinese opera outreach ministry among youth in the New Territories area of Hong Kong.



Harvey Fellows Program

The Foundation initiated the *Harvey Fellows Program* in 1992. The goal of the program is to mark, equip, and encourage followers of Jesus Christ who seek to actively integrate their faith and vocations as leaders in strategic occupations where Christians appear to be underrepresented. This idea grew from our understanding of God as Creator and Redeemer, not only of human beings, but also of society's disciplines and structures. Our desire is to identify, prepare, and celebrate this generation's Josephs, Lydias, Daniels, and Esthers – Christians who will assume positions of leadership and influence in society. The Harvey Fellowship is a stipend of \$16,000 that may be renewed for up to two additional years. The award is given to outstanding students enrolled at a premier graduate degree program and is therefore very competitive. Harvey Fellows typically attend schools considered by professionals to be among the top five globally in a given subject area or specialty.

A significant component of the program is participation in a weeklong summer program that provides a forum for discussion on integrating faith and vocation. The Summer Institute is a place for Fellows to meet and build relationships with others with similar visions. The Foundation believes this occasion is vital for the marking and equipping of Fellows. The Institute was held in Washington, DC in 2010 with 34 participants.

In 2010 the Foundation invested \$962,906 in support of 81 graduate students preparing to enter strategic ministry in academia, the arts, and the marketplace. We were privileged to award 23 new fellowships to an extraordinary group of graduate students representing a variety of nationalities and preparing for vocations in diverse fields.

Theological Education Scholarships

For more than fifteen years, the Foundation has partnered with theological institutions in Africa, Asia, Eastern Europe, Latin America and the Middle East to provide scholarships to individuals preparing to take leadership positions in local churches and Christian organizations. By 2007, the program had grown to support thousands of seminarians in several dozen theological institutions around the world with scholarships totaling well over \$1 million annually. Following the global economic downturn in 2008 and 2009, the Foundation decided to suspend the program for a year to determine how to continue the scholarship.

Beginning in 2010, The Foundation continued the *Theological Education Program* on a more limited basis; making investments in the types of students we found the most joy in supporting in the past. We chose to prioritize our support for those seminarians who have particularly compelling personal stories and who are more likely to be considered unique within their context. Many of these students either came from different faith backgrounds, have unusual upbringings, or have other distinguishing characteristics considered unique among their peers.

In 2010 we invested a total of \$300,000 in scholarships to 193 students to enable them to pursue formal theological education at 31 institutions around the world.



BGU Scholarships

Since 2005, the Mustard Seed Foundation has provided scholarships to students at *Bakke Graduate University* (BGU) based in Seattle, Washington. These scholarships focus on encouraging ministry practitioners to obtain advanced degrees to deepen the theological basis of their work and ministry. Most of those supported are pursuing the Doctorate of Ministry (DMin) degree in Transformational Leadership for the Global City that is offered through BGU on a non-residential, modular basis. The Foundation also supported a handful of students pursuing a Master of Arts of Social and Civic Entrepreneurship (MASCE), Master of Arts in Global Urban Leadership (MAGUL), or a Master of Business Administration (MBA). Scholarships are awarded in honor of Dr. Raymond J. Bakke, Dr. Lowell Bakke, Mrs. Marilyn Bakke Pearson and Mr. Dennis W. Bakke who have contributed significantly to the ministry of the Mustard Seed Foundation and formation of Bakke Graduate University.

In 2010, we were pleased to award scholarships through BGU for the advanced studies of 147 ministry practitioners totaling \$299,929. These talented men and women come from and serve in a variety of urban centers around the world where they are actively responding to God's calling in ministry.



Theology of Work

The *Theology of Work* (TOW) grant program was established in 2007 by the Mustard Seed Foundation in collaboration with the Bakke Graduate University (BGU). The aim of this special grant initiative is to enable theological institutions and training organizations worldwide to instruct seminarians, pastors, and educators in a biblical basis of a theology of work. It is our desire to see those trained through our grants begin teaching and modeling this theological concept in their own churches and ministries. This theological understanding empowers lay people to infuse their Christian faith in the institutions, structures, and industries in which they work throughout the week.

Theology of Work grants are awarded to theological institutions, both formal and non-formal, to create and offer courses that teach students a theology of work to enable them to teach others. The institutions are encouraged to integrate this theology into their core curriculum to continue to teach the course after the grant-funded classes are completed. The TOW grants program is administered by BGU, which fosters a network of people and resources specializing in developing and teaching curriculum for theology of work.

In 2010 we awarded 40 grants totaling \$349,096 to seminaries and ministries worldwide. Over 6,500 students participated in courses in hopes that through them churches will actively teach and encourage their congregants a strong theology of work.


